SITE WALK

Long Horizon Development – 8679 and 8684 Pond Street

Present were Alternate Commissioner Statchen, Assistant Town Planner Rutherford and applicant George Touponse.

The site walk began at approximately 9:00 AM.

The property corners and wetland flags were visible and easily identified. The utility poles along the frontage were located and served as a close representation of the front property corners. These existing physical features were used to estimate the location of the proposed work and understand the scope of the disturbance within the wetland, watercourse and upland area.

During the site walk it was discussed to possibly relocate the north leg of the swale further south to join into a finger of the swale that already exists. Also discussed was limiting the tree removal to the limit of work and some isolated trees within the wetland area that are dead.

The site walk ended at approximately 9:20 AM.
