EXPLANATION:

For FY2018/2019 the Town Council approved a \$55,000 cash appropriation and the voters in a town-wide referendum approved an appropriation of \$209,000 for total funding of \$264,000 to replace Sections O,Q, R, and U of the Farmington High School Roof. Recently an application for a school construction reimbursement grant was filed with the Office of School Construction Grants & Review for this project indicating that the estimated total cost is \$265,975 thereby showing a shortfall in funding of \$1,975. Before the Office of School Construction Grants & Review will consider a school construction project application they require proof that sufficient funding is in place at the local level for the project. This transfer will cover the \$1,975 shortfall and should assist in demonstrating to the State that sufficient funding is in place.
