Day 1: Join us on a journey south to experience the charming hospitality and beautiful sunsets of Charleston and Savannah. Following a 7:00 AM departure from the Farmington Community & Senior Center, 321 New Britain Avenue, Unionville, CT, we will head to Fredericksburg, VA. We check into our hotel for the night, the Holiday Inn Express & Suites in Fredericksburg, VA. Dinner is on own.

Day 2: This morning, after breakfast, we will leave Fredericksburg and continue south to Charleston, SC. On our way, we make a stop at the Charlotte Douglas Airport to pick up any Air Package Travelers. Upon arrival, we will check into our hotel for the next two nights, the Hotel Indigo Mount Pleasant. Tonight's dinner is included at Hyman's Seafood Restaurant. (B, D)

Day 3: Today, after breakfast at the hotel, we will embark on a guided tour of Charleston. Charleston is one of the most beautiful and historic cities in the south. Admire the beautiful architecture of the historic buildings and colorful houses throughout the city. The tour will conclude at the Charleston City Market to enjoy lunch, on our own. This afternoon, we will leave the city for Wadmalaw Island, where we enjoy a guided tour at the beautiful Charleston Tea Plantation. From here we make a stop at the Deep Water Vineyard. While here, we enjoy a wine tasting of 9 different wines. After, it's back to Charleston, where we will board The Spirit of Carolina for a dinner cruise! (B, D)

Day 4: After breakfast, we're off and out again, making our way to Beaufort, SC! Historic Beaufort, was founded in 1711, and stands strong as a living landmark, handcrafted from the storied history of the south. We will enjoy a horse drawn carriage tour of Beaufort, have time for lunch and to do some shopping before we resume our journey south to Savannah, GA. After checking into the Hotel Indigo Savannah Historic District, we head to Belford's Seafood & Steak for dinner. (B, D)

Day 5: This morning, we meet our guide following breakfast for a full day of touring. Our journey includes a visit to the Andrew Low House, former home of Juliette Magill Gordon Low, the founder of the Girl Scouts of America, and Andrew Low himself. This afternoon, we stop at the Savannah City Market for lunch, on own, before our tour to the Atlantic Low Country and Tybee Island. This evening's dinner is included at the Crab Shack on Tybee Island, followed by a relaxing sunset dolphin cruise. What a way to complete this wonderful day! (B, D)

Day 6: Breakfast is included this morning before we start making our way home. Today we say farewell to Georgia & South Carolina. We will make a stop at the Charleston International Airport for any of our fellow Air Package Travelers before stopping in Richmond, VA for the evening. We will spend the night at the Courtyard Marriott Richmond North. Dinner is on own. (B)
