

<u>DAY ONE</u> - This morning, we will depart from your area en route to **Bar Harbor**, **Maine!** Vacationland welcomes you, as we make our way north to **Rockland**, the Lobster Capital of the World. Lunch today will be on your own in Rockland, where you will see Rockland harbor lighthouse from the new waterfront park with a boardwalk. Visit the **Maine Lighthouse Museum** in Rockland, which houses a unique collection of historic artifacts of the US Coast Guard and local lighthouse culture. Then sit back and relax for your drive along the coast "downeast" to **Bar Harbor**. This afternoon, we will check in to the **Atlantic Eyrie Lodge** in Bar Harbor for a three-night stay. Dinner is included this evening at a nearby restaurant.

After this amazing tour, you will have free time for **lunch on your own in Bar Harbor** and some time to explore shops, boutiques and galleries in downtown Bar Harbor. For those looking for more nature-based activities to spend your free time, there are also two parks and a shoreline walking trail for you to enjoy. This afternoon, enjoy the **Abbe Museum – Maine's most extensive Native American heritage museum in Bar Harbor** for a guided tour focusing on the four tribes in Maine (Maliseet, Micmac, Passamaquoddy, and Penobscot). We will then return to the hotel, where we will freshen up for dinner. Be sure to wear your souvenir **Maine Lobster Hat** for a **Traditional Maine Lobsterbake** dinner with all the fixin's this evening! (Alternate meals are steak or haddock.)

<u>DAY THREE</u> - A deluxe continental breakfast is included at the hotel this morning. After breakfast, you will take a two hour Sightseeing/Nature Cruise of Frenchman's Bay. Cruise along the calm waters of the harbor and see a variety of marine life on this narrated excursion. You will head to a small island to look at harbor seals basking on the rocks and enjoy the majestic scenery of the Maine coast. Enjoy a second day of Bar Harbor free time with lunch on your own to explore more of the beautiful town. We'll take a leisurely stroll with a guide through Bar Harbor to learn of its historic past and hear tales of how it grew into both a summer haven and year-found residences for many Euro-Americans. You'll also learn how previously established Indian encampments had to adapt as the town grew with new people.
