A. Call to Order.

The meeting was called to order at 9:16 A.M.

B. Approval of the Minutes from the June 11, 2020 FHS Building Committee Communications Subcommittee.

Upon a motion made and seconded (Siuta/Mazzochi) it was unanimously VOTED: to approve the minutes from the June 11, 2020 meeting.

C. Subcommittee Updates.

1. Video Tour and Other Videos.

Scott Hurwitz stated that he was worked with Evan Foreman to create footage for an FHS video tour. He stated that the footage does not include students because the school has been closed to students due to COVID-19. He asked the subcommittee members for their input regarding whether more footage should be shot when school is back in session.

Ryszard Szczypek stated that videos with students would be more helpful and effective for viewers to get a better picture of how the school functions on a daily basis. Scott agreed and noted that future footage would still not reflect a typical day at FHS due accommodations for COVID-19.

It was determined that more footage would be shot when students return to the FHS facility and that Scott would narrate the tour. These videos have a target release date for the fall.

2. Side-by-side Photos.

Meg Guerrera stated that she did not have an update for this item. She stated that she will work on this. Kara Gruss offered to assist Meg with this item.

3. Newsletter Update to Farmington Community.

Meg Guerrera stated that the Town Newsletter included a blurb regarding the FHS Building Committee. She also stated that the upcoming School District Newsletter will include a blurb on the committee.

4. Landing Page on Committee Website.

Mark Garilli stated that CSG and TSKP Studio held a meeting to discuss the landing page of the FHS Building Committee website. Mark presented a mock-up of the landing page (recorded with these minutes as Attachment A) and a site map for the mock-up (recorded with these minutes as Attachment B) created by Construction Solutions Group based on the meeting they held with TSKP Studio.

Ryszard Szczypek suggested that the subcommittee include the Schematic Design Report on the landing page of the website. Subcommittee members agreed.

Subcommittee members complimented the mock-up and felt that it addressed the recommendations provided at the June 11^{th} meeting. The subcommittee approved and gave CSG permission to update the committee website accordingly.

5. Postcard Update to Farmington Community.

Devon Aldave presented a draft informational postcard recorded with these minutes as Attachment C. Subcommittee members and members of the public made the following suggestions:

- Include "Update" at the end of the Header of the postcard.
- Move the image on the bottom left of the front page above the text and make the image larger.
- Move the image on the bottom right of the front page to the back page.
- Make the text on the front page more concise.

Devon will make the recommended changes and send out an updated draft to the subcommittee members.

6. Other Updates.

Meg Guerrera stated that the subcommittee will have future discussions about when the appropriate time would be to bring on Tall Timbers Marketing for communications support.

Ellen Siuta suggested creating a press release to announce the new landing page for the committee website when it is live.


