Discussion onf Next Steps for the FHS Building Project

#### NOTE:

At the January 26, 2021 Town Council meeting, the FHSBC presented the schematic design and project cost overview. The following items required additional information for discussion at this meeting. I've provided a summary of discussion points below:

- 1928 Building
  - Presently the demolition of the 1928 building is included in the proposed project, as there is no educational use for the building.
  - There is a renovation estimate for \$9,821,700. The Town Council needs clarity on what is included in this renovation.
  - o Another option is to mothball the 1928 building for \$1,042,300.
  - Establish a Town Council Ad- Hoc Committee to review options for the future use of the 1928 building to add as a separate referendum question.
- Additional Exclusions- These items are not included in the base budget. The FHSBC needs direction if these items should be added into the project.
  - o Route 4 Improvements-\$763,300
  - Alternative Energy Savings-\$676,200 /Net Zero Building-\$9,144,800
- Referendum Timeframe-
  - The FHSBC needs direction on the anticipated timeframe for a referendum on the FHS Building Project.
    - Discussion on a June referendum date- attached is a draft schedule, with 2 proposed referendum dates, for consideration.
- Discussion of Additional questions from January 26, 2021 Town Council Meeting

FHS Building Committee members and the project's professional partners will be available at the meeting to answer any questions and facilitate the discussion points.
