A. Call to Order

The Chair called the meeting to order at 7:01 pm.

B. New Business

1) To Adjourn to Executive Session Related to the Town Clerk.

Motion was made and seconded (Mastrobattista/Capodiferro) to move to Executive Session at 7:02 p.m. to discuss personnel matters related to the Town Clerk. The attendance in the Executive Session shall be limited to the Town Council and the Town Clerk, Paula Ray.

Adopted unanimously.

Paula Ray left Executive Session at 7:33 p.m.

The Town Council returned to open session at 7:38 p.m.

2) To Adjourn to Executive Session related to the Town Manager Performance Evaluation.

Motion was made and seconded (Mastrobattista/Capodiferro) to move to Executive Session at 7:39 p.m. to discuss matters pertaining to the Town Manager regarding performance evaluation and the attendance in Executive Session shall be limited to the Town Council and Kathleen Blonski, Town Manager.

Adopted unanimously.

The Town Council returned to open session at 8:23 p.m.

3) To Take Any Action on the Town Manager's Employment Contract.

Motion was made and seconded (Mastrobattista/Capodiferro) to amend the Town Manager's contract to July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2025.

Adopted Unanimously.

Motion was made and seconded (Mastrobattista/Capodiferro) to set the Town Manager's annual base salary at \$182,881, a 3% increase for the 2021/2022 fiscal year.

Adopted Unanimously.

Motion was made and seconded (Mastrobattista/Capodiferro) to contribute a one-time lump sum of \$10,000 to her Vantage Care Retirement Health Savings Plan.

Adopted Unanimously.

Motion was made and seconded (Mastrobattista/Capodiferro) that the Town will contribute 5% of the Town's Manager's salary to the Town Manager's Vantage Care Retirement Health Savings Plan through the International City Management Association (ICMA). The Town Manager will contribute at least 2.5% and may contribute up to 5%.

Adopted Unanimously.

4) To Set the Town Clerk's Salary for Fiscal Year 2021-2022.

Motion was made and seconded (Mastrobattista/Capodiferro) to set the Town Clerk's salary at \$114,402 a 2.75% increase for the fiscal year 2021-2022.

Adopted Unanimously.
