

TRAFFIC COMMITTEE MEETING

Meeting commenced at 1:00 p.m in the Chief's Conference Room

Present at Meeting: Captain Ryan, Officer Frink, Jim Ruzbasan, Dennis Frazao, Jim Platosh and Amber Rush

0422-01: Resident is concerned about speeding on Meadow Road

Officer Frink was able to gather extensive data before this meeting which showed that nearly 85% of the drivers were driving within 38-42 mph. Also, in looking back 3 ½ years, while there were 18 accidents, 7 were caused by deer in the road and 5 were from being rear-ended at the stoplight. Given this information the data does not support asking the state to lower the speed limit.

Item is Closed.

0422-02: Resident is requesting to remove the islands on Judson Lane so cars can pass.

As the islands were specifically placed there to prevent passing, for the safety of the school children, it would be irresponsible to remove the islands.

Item is Closed.

1021-03: Request for flashing crosswalk lights on Lovely Street.

While the State declined the request, the **Town of Farmington has decided to install the lights.**

Item is Closed.

0122-01: Issue regarding confusing and inaccurate signage on School Street for Noah Wallace.

Group agreed that the three signs (One way, No Right Turn, and then a smaller sign with times for no right turn) were confusing. Group decided it would make the most sense to have the times of the No Right Turn placed ON that sign with the font enlarged, so there would only be two signs, and it would be clearer what the No Right Turn sign was for.

Town Highway to reach out to sign company to have this sign made.

Item is Closed, unless the company can't produce this sign. If that's the case, item will continue to be discussed.
