

## **TRAFFIC COMMITTEE MEETING**

### **Wednesday, September 21, 2022**

Meeting commenced at 1:00 p.m. in the Chief's Conference Room

Present at Meeting: Chief Ryan, Anna Savastano, Lt Egan, Sgt Stone, Dennis Franzi, Jim Ruzbasan and Amber Rush

#### **New Business:**

**0922-01:** Resident is requesting a “no outlet” sign be posted on Ships Oak Lane, to stop people from trying to use it as a cut-through thinking it meets up with Plainville Ave.

- Group agreed that a “no outlet” sign could be installed. **Town Highway to install sign.**  
**Item is Closed**

**0922-02:** Resident is requesting to add warning signs, advising of a school bus stop ahead, east and west of 303 South Road.

- Group determined that the sign is needed on the east side, as the line of sight on the west is sufficient. **Town Highway to look to see where best spot is to put sign and will report back.**  
**Item is Tabled**

**0922-03:** Resident is requesting adding No Parking signs on the north and south side of 2 Mountain Lane to Mountain Spring, to prevent parked vehicles from congesting the intersection.

- The Town ordinance 182-1 prohibits parking within 25 feet of an intersection, so erecting signs aren't necessary. The Police Department continue to periodically check for violations and Town Manager's Office will advise resident to contact the Police Department if she sees any parking violations.  
**Item is Closed**

**0922-04:** Request for either a sidewalk to go up and continue up mountain on the north side of the street, or a crosswalk on the south side of the street between Hillstead and Mountain Road

- Group discussed that installing a sidewalk in that area isn't feasible, but it may be possible to install a crosswalk. Town Highway to look to see if the Field Hockey Fields line up with the Hillstead Museum, to allow for a crosswalk to be painted.  
**Item is Tabled**

**0922-05:** Resident is requesting speed bumps or flashing signs on Wood Pond Road. Concerned for safety of pedestrians, kids, etc., as there aren't any sidewalks and cars speed down the road on a daily basis.

- Traffic Officer Frink to install speed signs to accumulate data to see if speeding is an issue that would warrant additional action.
