1928 Building Project Update

- The town-wide survey indicated strong support to preserve the 1928 building.
 Space for Town operations, recreational space, and community use are needed town-wide and can be accommodated in the 1928 building. The 1928 Building Committee has been working hard to evaluate these needs.
- The Town Council received a presentation from Chris Nardi of Silver Petrucelli + Associates, 1928 Project Architects. The major takeaways from this presentation included:
 - Option 2 (Retention of 1928 building plus other existing buildings) far exceeds the operational space needs of the Town, creates a physical separation between the high school and tennis courts which would cause parking/circulation conflicts, and would be costly due to size.
 - Option 1 (Retention of standalone 1928 building) meets the Town's operational needs. The band room was determined to be original to the 1928 building and this space can be used as multi-purpose recreational space.
- Based on Silver Petrucelli's presentation and a recommendation from the 1928
 Building Committee, the Town Council voted to eliminate Option 2 (Retention
 of 1928 building plus other existing buildings) from the 1928 Building
 Committee's charge. This will allow the 1928 Building Committee to
 concentrate their efforts on Option 1 (Retention of standalone 1928 building).
