  - 1. Anti-Idling:

1. Simple Recycling update

- 1. Annual Town Wide Clean-up Day
  - 1) The committee discussed the following items:
    - 1. The annual clean up will occur on Earth Day, Saturday, April 22<sup>nd</sup>.
    - 2. Household Hazardous waste and shredding will occur separately on Saturday March 25<sup>th</sup>.
    - 3. Expenditure request date stickers for signs no action taken
- 2. EV Charger
  - 1) Staff is waiting on quotes from installers before proceeding. The committee discussed the inclusion of the infrastructure for EV chargers as part of the new High School project. Staff would prefer to select a charger and have a common charger used throughout town.
- 3. Update on Miniature bottle fee
  - 1) Staff updated the committee on the miniature bottle fee that is collected by municipalities following the 2021 legislative session. The town is currently putting the fee toward refurbishment or replacement of the town street sweeper.
