# CHAIR REPORT

February 28, 2023

## NEW & NOTEWORTHY

- The Town Manager, the Board of Education, and Town Staff presented the Town Manager's Proposed Seven Year Capital Improvement Plan (CIP).
- Town Department Heads had the opportunity to present their capital budget requests to the Town Council and answer any questions.
- The Town Council had consensus to proceed with a "barebones" CIP for Fiscal Year 2023-2024 in an effort to mitigate the tax impact from the State-mandated revaluation. The Town of Farmington has consistently funded capital projects over the last decade, so the Council was comfortable with using this strategy to lessen the burden on residential taxpayers.
