Chairman Mastrobattista reminded the Committee that he would be presenting this to the Town Council at their April 3, 2023, Town Council meeting.

Upon a motion made and seconded (Fagan, Baron) it was unanimously VOTED: to approve the attached Value Engineering list and recommend a three-phase Value Engineering approach to the Town Council
