New Business:

0523-01: Request for flashing lights and/or signage to alert drivers of pedestrians and bicyclists crossing to and from the trail at New Britain Avenue/Meadow Road intersection.

The group discussed that there is a 4-way stop sign at each corner and the line of sight is clear. Adding additional lights or signage wouldn't be as effective as the 4-way-stop sign. The Police Department will continue to have a presence in this area to ensure traffic safety. Item is closed.

0623-01: Concerns with speeding, safety for residents on Berkshire/Robin.

Speed boxes were deployed on 6/7/23 for a week with 85% of the data showing speeds at Robin Road were between 18 and 23 mph and Berkshire Road speeds averaged 26-28 mph. It was noted that each day around 6pm one person sped down Berkshire at around 55 mph. Patrol will be doing selective enforcement in that area around 6pm to ensure speed limits are followed. Preliminary studies also showed southbound volume at 6,760 cars and northbound at 4,192 cars. The group discussed volume being high due vehicles cutting through Berkshire to avoid the new construction that is taking place. Before any action could be taken, the group recommended tabling this item for the next meeting when we can look at the data from volume of cars this year vs last and see if we were able to curtail the speeding. Item is tabled.

0623-02: Request for sign prohibiting trucks on River Road.

The group discussed that there isn't an engineering need, and it isn't feasible or practical to prohibit trucks from driving on River Road. It was suggested that people contact the Police Department immediately if there's a particular truck that is causing issues, so that issue can be addressed. The police department will continue to have a presence in this area to ensure traffic safety. Item is closed.

0623-03: Request for either blind driveway sign or "slow down" sign by 165 Coppermine Road

The group discussed that the "Hidden Driveway" sign is no longer an MUTCD recognized sign. Besides selective enforcement in this area, it was suggested that the line of sight could be improved by homeowner cutting back the trees on their property. Item is closed.

0623-04: Concern regarding timing of light at Waterville/Route 4, particularly during rush hour.

This concern has been an on-going issue that has been addressed previously (TRB # 0710-01). Letters have been written to the State DOT requesting they try to adjust the timing of the light. As the timing of the light is the State's responsibility, the best solution we can provide would be to continue to monitor the situation and perform selective enforcement in that area. Item is Closed.
