New Business : 1223-01: Request for removal of sign placed in front of 1615 Farmington Avenue.

Russ Arnold shared with the group details about a recent state Department of Transportation (DOT) initiative. Under this program, larger 42-inch stop signs are being installed to replace smaller ones. As part of this program, additional warning signs are being placed . An example of this update can be observed at 1615 Farmington Avenue, where Highwood Road now features the larger stop sign. The Town Manager's Office will contact the state Department of Transportation (DOT) to assess the necessity of the sign and will send the complainant a letter to keep him apprised of the status.
