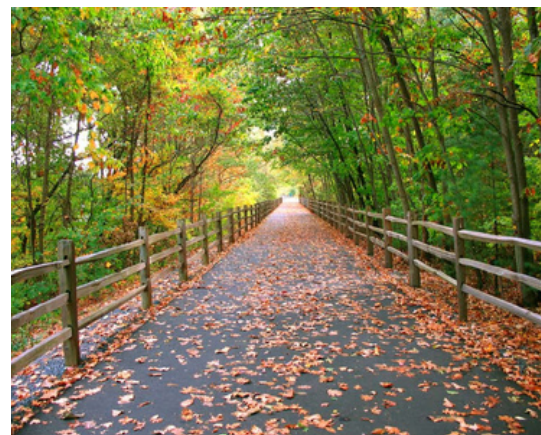

OVERVIEW

The Town of Farmington seeks to engage the services of a Golf Professional to manage and operate the Pro Shop, driving range, and golf carts at Westwoods Golf Course, an 18-hole executive golf course. The Golf Professional offers individual and group lessons, camps and clinics, and schedules and manages leagues and tournaments. The Golf Professional also coordinates and oversees course staff and works collaboratively with municipal departments including the Recreation Department and golf course maintenance crew.

REQUIRED EXPERIENCE

- PGA or LPGA membership
- Proven experience as a Head Golf Professional, Assistant Golf Professional, or a similar role in golf management

COMPENSATION

- Compensation shall be negotiated based on qualifications
- The Golf Professional will sign a contract with the Town of Farmington

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Offer individual and group lessons on a regular schedule that are sufficient to meet the needs of the golfing public and to promote new golfers.
- Sell, account, and maintain records for daily green fees, golf cart rentals, driving range fees, season tickets, and gift certificates.
- Interpret and impose course policies, rules, and regulations to ensure safety and fair play.
- Deliver outstanding customer service to members, guests, and visitors, ensuring a positive and memorable golfing experience.
- Handle and resolve member and guest inquiries, concerns, and complaints in a professional and courteous manner.
- Build and maintain strong relationships with members and guests to foster a sense of community and loyalty.
- Coordinate tournaments, events, and leagues, ensuring they run smoothly and efficiently.
- Oversee retail merchandise concession in step with the mission of the golf operation and facility, while maintaining profitability.
- Supervise physical inventories, presenting a diverse and desirable array of golf equipment, apparel, and accessories.
- Oversee the control and rental of riding golf carts to golfers on behalf of the Town of Farmington.
- Supervise and operate the driving range, collect all fees from the use of the range and the sale of range balls.

WHO WE ARE

Established in 1645, Farmington is one of the oldest communities in the state, rich with colonial history and heritage. With its vibrant landscapes, excellent schools, and a thriving local economy, Farmington seamlessly integrates its storied past with a progressive present, making it a desirable place to live, work, play, and prosper.

Farmington has a Council-Manager form of government with a Council Chairperson as the Chief Elected Official and a Town Manager as the Chief Executive Officer.

Farmington currently employs 158 Full-Time Employees and 153 part-time employees. The Town's FY 24/25 operating budget is \$35M. Recreation is funded through a special revenue fund with a FY 24/25 budget of \$1.3M.
