#### A. Call to Order.

The chair called the meeting to order at 2:06 PM

#### B. Public Comment.

Tim Kelly, 62 Westview Terrae, Unionville, stated that he has been watching the process with lots of interest. He believes that at this juncture, the committee should reset and look at a tactical approach, or an "Option E," that addresses the issues that absolutely have to be fixed. Mr. Kelly also discussed concerns with enrollment, sprawl, security, and energy savings. He asked what the tangible outcomes of the project are and if colleges or universities have provided any input.

### C. To review conceptual options "A" and "D" and discuss ways to reduce the size and cost.

Marc Sklenka, Colliers International, detailed the objectives of the subcommittee to re-develop the two distinct options "A" and "D." A copy of his outline is recorded with these minutes as Agenda Item C.

The subcommittee had general discussion regarding the two options, as summarized below:

- The goal of the subcommittee is to reduce the square footage for Farmington High School to 242,000 square feet.
- The subcommittee discussed enrollment and if the number can be adjusted.
- The subcommittee questioned if the fourth field is necessary.

- Bill Wadsworth shared his analysis of the square footage in the
  existing building to the proposed designs. He indicated that the gym,
  number of classrooms, mechanical space and black box theater are the
  "big ticket items" that are much larger than the current facility has.
- Kathy Greider answered the subcommittee's questions and suggestions for where space can be reduced, including the size of the corridors and mechanical space.
- Bill Wadsworth presented an Option "A" that keeps as much of the
  existing building as possible. Bill will work with Kaestle Boos on the
  design and cost of this building to reach the project budget goal.
- The subcommittee charged Kaestle Boos and school administration to evaluate the suggestions made by the subcommittee and work to reduce the size and cost for options "A" and "D" aiming for a goal of 242,000 square feet for the high school. These designs will be reviewed by the subcommittee at their meeting on Friday, February 3, 2017.

#### D. Other Business.

The committee reviewed the proposed schedule which has the following key dates:

- January 30, 2017- Kaestle Boos commences design of new options
- February 17, 2017- Kaestle Boos completes design of new options
- February 20, 2017- O&G commences cost estimating for new designs
- March 1, 2017- Estimates due
- March 3-7, 2017- Total project budgets are developed
- March 8, 2017- FHS Building Committee selects preferred option
- March 9, 2017- Kaestle Boos commences schematic design drawings
- April 13, 2017- Kaestle Boos completes schematic design package
- April 14, 2017- O&G commences cost estimating
- April 28, 2017-0&G completes cost estimate
- May 2, 2017- Total Project Budget Due
- June 5, 2017- Proposed date for Town Meeting
- June 15, 2017- Proposed Referendum Date

Kathy Eagen questioned when the high school graduation date is scheduled and Kathy Greider informed the subcommittee that the graduation date is not determined until April. A finalized referendum date will be determined after the graduation date is set.

The subcommittee will meet again next Friday, February 3, 2017 at 2:00 PM in Town Hall Council Chambers and set another meeting for Friday, February 10, 2017 at 2:00 PM in Town Hall Council Chambers. The subcommittee will provide an update to the FHS Building Committee at the February 8, 2017 regular meeting.
